

#### **Client's Testimony**


David Downs, the ninth of ten children, was born on a Navy base in Charleston, South Carolina, and was raised in Frayser, TN after his family moved to the Navy base in Millington when he was three years old. Though brought up in church, David's life took a difficult turn at age 15 when his father died of a heart attack. Grieving and confused, he turned to drugs and alcohol, drifting away from his faith.

Years later, David married a woman named Sharna who helped him reconnect with the Lord. Unfortunately, their marriage ended after David was unfaithful. Heartbroken and

Heartbroken and filled with regret, he returned to substance abuse and spent the next 20 years as a functioning addict, working long hours in construction just to get by. In his 30s, the death of his mother deeply impacted him. She had often told him to get

In his 30s, the death of his mother deeply impacted him. She had often told him to get his life straight and warned him that he would miss her when she was gone. Though her passing prompted some attempts to return to church, David continued to struggle,

repeatedly falling back into addiction.



But last March 2024, everything changed. David checked in once again—this time with a serious commitment to surrender his life to Christ, get sober, and truly follow the Lord. He repented, was discipled, and was baptized at Berclair Baptist Church last summer. Since then, he has remained faithful in his walk with Christ. He regularly attends Berclair and has been asked to serve as a door greeter or help with lawn care—roles he's genuinely excited about as he continues to grow in faith and purpose.

David joined the staff at Calvary about a year ago and now serves faithfully in the kitchen. He asks for

Since the chapel was built for the men who come to Calvary Rescue Mission, we wanted them to be the first to worship there. During our weekly staff meeting on Tuesday, we decided that we had everything needed to hold chapel services in the new building, but we needed a couple of days to put everything in place. It was decided that we could start having chapel in our new building on Thursday, July 3rd. The first Thursday of each month is Frank Sizemore's regular night to preach at Calvary Rescue Mission, so he gave the very first message delivered there.
